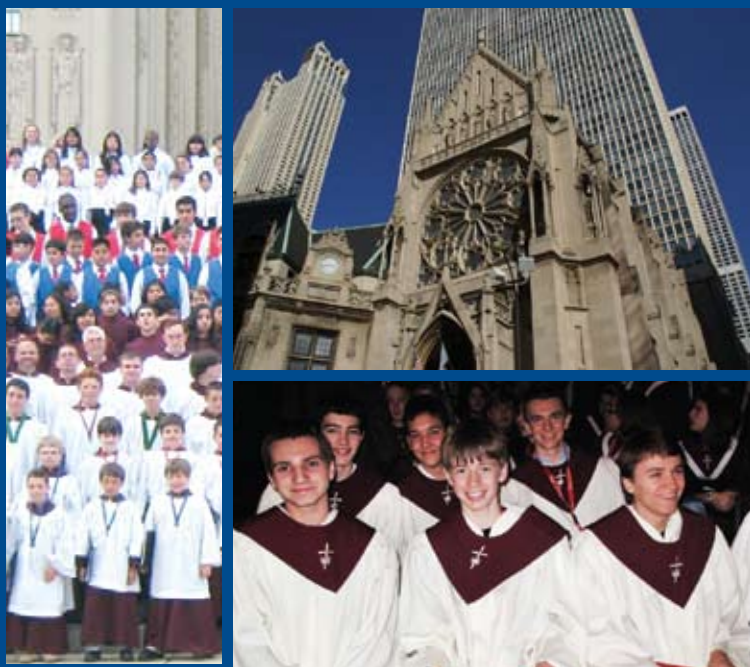

- Attire is black or uniform skirts/pants and white shirts or blouses
- Commemorative medallions will be presented to all singers
- A demo CD will be forwarded to registered conductors after October 15
- This historic Mass will be nationally publicized throughout the United States
