

MEET THE CONDUCTOR

DR. ALFRED CALABRESE enjoys a diverse career as conductor, educator, composer, scholar, and church musician. He is Director of Music at Saint Rita Catholic Church in Dallas, TX, where he oversees a music program with five choirs including the St. Rita Choral Academy (for children), professional singers and organists, and other staff members. Dr. Calabrese holds the Master of Music at Indiana Doctor of Music degrees in Conducting from the Jacobs School of Music at Indiana University. He has previously served as director of choral activities at Southern Methodist University, Emory University, and Brevard College, and a visiting Professor at Indiana University, guest lecturer at the University of Notre Dame, the University of South Carolina, and the Conservatoire de Versailles. He has been a guest conductor and clinician in America and abroad and is an active composer, focusing on writing music for liturgical use.
