Pueri Cantores, the national student choral organization of the Catholic Church, and The Cathedral of the Madeleine are excited to bring this Mini-Masterworks High School Festival to Salt Lake City. All high school choirs are invited to participate in this enriching event!

This two-day event is a wonderful opportunity for high school students to come together to study a sacred choral masterwork and perform it together with a chamber orchestra. Under the direction of the conductor, the choirs will rehearse Ēriks Ešenvalds' "Trinity Te Deum" and prepare the work for a public performance. Within this festival format we will introduce young people to important sacred masterworks and provide them with an opportunity to further explore their interest in this liturgical art form that has resonated throughout Catholic churches and cathedrals for hundreds of years. Individual choirs will also have the opportunity to perform two sacred choral selections of their choosing during the concert.
