Church Music Institute
On-line Sacred Music Library

The Church Music Institute contains an extensive Library of Sacred Choral and Organ Music that supports the educational purposes of the Institute. CMI members may select music that meets musical, liturgical, and theological requirements for every church through its electronic, online catalogue.

The Choral Library contains nearly 17,000 anthems researched in eighteen fields such as Level of Difficulty, Scripture, Lectionary Reference. Three search fields may be combined in the search process, and anthems have PDF examples.

Search Fields of unusual interest are:

- Multi-movement Composition: Cantatas; Lessons and Carols
- Additional Choir (primary choir with congregation or children's choir)

The Sacred Music Library also contains the Institute's Sacred Organ Music collection. More than 11,000 titles may be searched by Tune Name to locate organ compositions appropriate for worship planning. Each title is researched in nine search fields such as Composer, Editor, Instruments, and Level of Difficulty. As with the Choral Library, multiple search fields may be combined in the search process.

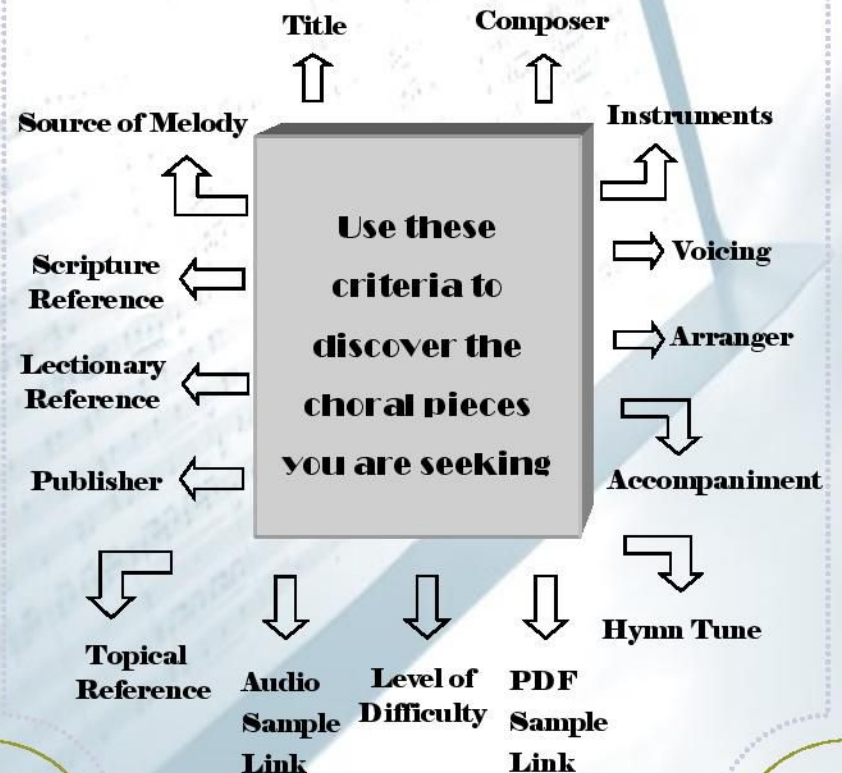
