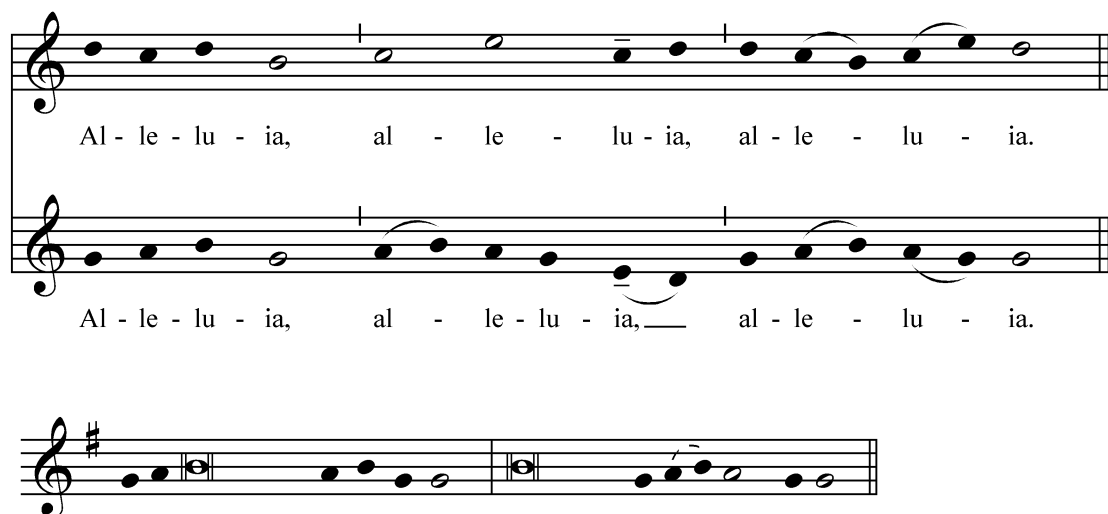


AMERICAN FEDERATION PUERI CANTORES - 2027
