About the Festival

Pueri Cantores, the national student choral organization of the Catholic Church, invites all parish and school mixed voice and treble choirs in the Archdiocese of Miami and neighboring dioceses, to participate in a Festival and Mass for singers in grades 4-12.

Singers join together as one large combined choir to sing a liturgical music repertoire spanning 1500 years – from Gregorian chant to masterworks of the twenty-first century.

Choirs will begin this all-day festival with rehearsals before the mass. Choirs may also choose to participate individually in the choral prelude preceding the festival mass. If you would like your choir to participate in the prelude, please choose one 2-4 minute composition that will best showcase your choir in this liturgical setting and submit a printed copy of your musical choice along with your registration. The first five choirs to submit their registration and printed music will be accepted to sing and further enrich their experience.
